



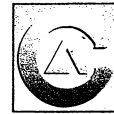

Ratkovich Company Donates \$5,000 to Alhambra Educational Foundation

The Ratkovich Company presented a \$5,000 donation to the Alhambra Educational Foundation in December for the foundation's defibrillator program.

Foundation President Steve Perry announced that each school in the Alhambra Unified School District will now have a defibrillator.
